With penitent hearts, we gather for worship. Though it is hard to be honest with ourselves, with each other and with God, we acknowledge that our lives are not what we hope they will be.


we acknowledge that our lives are not what we hope they will be. We have not loved God with our whole heart, soul, and mind; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.
