An update from PET on our transition process: On May 9, Large Group made a decision to move forward with seeking a Transitional Pastor to facilitate and assist us in reflecting, assessment, discovery, and making a path toward the future. Last Sunday, 24 people engaged each other in conversation, and gave input during a Listening Meeting (plus some emailed comments). That feedback is helping PET assess our situation and specify our desired focus as we work with our Conference Minister to find a Transitional pastor. We anticipate that transitional person may not be available to begin until after summer. PET is also developing plans for "short term" coverage of pastoral responsibilities, based on our discernment and LG suggestions.

Consider joining a "Pipeline to Prison" learning tour sponsored by MCC Great Lakes & Center for Community Justice. The tour will focus on the challenges and complexities of the U.S. criminal justice system, learning about law enforcement, sentencing, incarceration and re-entry.
